Recycling Guide

As part of our pledge to take an active role in reducing Newent's carbon footprint and in avoiding pollution, we aim to produce a series of A-Z posters. We start with A and B.

Local Recycling and Waste Disposal

- **Aerosols** (empty) - doorstep recycling collection box1 (tins and plastics)
- **Aluminium foil, trays and cans** - (clean foil and trays only) doorstep collection box 1
- **Animal waste and cat litter** - bag it and place in your black wheelie bin.
- **Asbestos** - small amounts of household asbestos can be disposed of at a Household Recycling Centre but you must book in advance of your visit (see below)
- **Ash** - untreated/unpainted wood ash can go in your compost bin. Otherwise, dispose of it like coal ash (let it cool first) and put into your black wheelie bin
- **Audio equipment** - take to The Recycling Shop or one of the local charity shops if in working order. Try the Mend & Repair Cafe if the equipment needs attention.
- **Baby nappies and wipes** - black wheelie bin
- **Batteries** - household batteries- wrap in a plastic bag, leave on top of the black wheelie bin
- **Books** - take to The Recycling Shop or one of the local charity shops
- **Bread bags** - can be used to line your food waste caddy
- **Brown paper** - clean brown wrapping paper can be torn up and put in your compost bin.
- **Broken glass** - wrap and place in your black wheelie bin.
- **Bubble wrap** - can be recycled with other soft plastics at the Large Co-op store by the photo booth
