

Recycling Guide

As part of our pledge to take an active role in reducing Newent's carbon footprint and in avoiding pollution, we are producing a series of A-Z posters. Here is 'I to L'.

- **Ice cream tubs** not currently recycled in this area.
- **Inkjet cartridges** take to the Household Waste and Recycling Centre (HRC) or find a local charity that collects them by freepost envelopes. Or visit https://www.recycle4charity.co.uk
- **Irons** can be left with other small electricals on top or your black waste bin in a plastic bag or taken to the HRC.
- **Ironing Boards** remove the cover and recycle as metal at the HRC.
- **Jars** recycle glass jars in your kerbside box. Metal lids can be recycled with tins in the plastic bottle kerbside box. Or make some jam or chutney!
- **Junk mail** place in the paper/cardboard kerbside recycling bag. Glossy paper is acceptable but not laminated items.
- **Kitchen paper -** in the general rubbish please.
- **Kitchen knives** as with all sharp objects, wrap carefully and place in the general rubbish.
- **Knitting wool** donate to local charity shops or The Recycling Shop.
- **Laptops** remove hard drive and take to the HRC for recycling.
- **Large electrical items** take to the HRC or pay £25 for up to three bulky items to be collected by arrangement with the FoDDC. (Four to six items for £50.)
- **Lawnmowers** try the Mend and Repair cafe if not working. Otherwise recycle as metal at the HRC. If in good condition, offer for free or for sale at various noticeboards.
- **Light bulbs** -take to the HRC site or large Tesco stores.
- **Liquids and chemicals** take to a Household Waste and Recycling Centre. Paint, oil and chemicals should never be placed in the general rubbish bin or enter the drainage system.
