

Recycling Guide

As part of our pledge to take an active role in reducing Newent's carbon footprint and in avoiding pollution, we are producing a series of A-Z posters. Here is 'S'.

- Sanitary Products do not flush down the toilet. Wrap and place in your black wheelie bin.
- **Saucepans** recycle as for metal at the Household Recycling Centres (HRCs)
- Sawdust Sawdust and other wood shavings are easily home compostable. Alternatively small amounts can go in your garden waste collection or be recycled at the Household Recycling Centres
- **School Uniform** Gooch Sports in Newent has a drop box for pre-loved school uniforms.
- **Sellotape, brown and parcel tape** cannot be recycled. Remove from paper before recycling.
- **Sewing machines** donate to charity shops or The Recycling Shop if working. Otherwise try the Mend and Repair cafe.
- **Shoes** paired shoes in wearable condition can be recycled though clothes banks or donated to charity shops.
- **Shredded paper -** can be collected with your kerbside recycling but please enclose in an envelope or paper bag to prevent spillage.
- Small electrical items bag and place on top of your black wheelie bin.
- **Sofas** take to the HRC or if usable and have a fire safety label attached, contact the Furniture Recycling Project in Gloucester who collect furniture and household items, including white goods and electricals (in working order) for resale. 01452 302303. https://frpglos.org.uk/Otherwise, contact the FoDDC for a paid-for collection.
- Soil and rubble take to the HRC.
- **Spectacles** ask your optician if they collect redundant spectacles for re-use elsewhere.
- **Styrofoam** place in your general waste.
