

Recycling Guide

As part of our pledge to take an active role in reducing Newent's carbon footprint, we encourage all residents to re-use, re-purpose and recycle as much as possible.

Here are some useful locations:

- Lakeside car park (Lewall St) in addition to larger containers for the usual kerbside recyclables, food and drink cartons, paper cups, textiles, shoes and bags.
- Co-op store, Market Square Salvation Army clothes bank for re-usable clothing, household linens, shoes and bags (car park), soft plastics (in-store by the photo booth)
- The Recycling Shop, Sheppard Way, GL18 1TL. Open Mon Fri 10-4. Extensive display of small items to large furniture at very affordable prices. Collection available. Donate or buy. Community Interest Company aiming to prevent waste.
- The Mend and Repair Cafe. Memorial Hall. Every third Saturday, 10-1pm. Knives/garden shears sharpened, items of clothing shortened, patched or repaired; broken toys mended, vacuum declogged, necklaces restrung, wooden chairs pinned and glued, and electrical items repaired if possible, by volunteers, all for a small donation. Coffee/tea and cake available to buy while you wait,
- Charity shops in Newent are always glad of donations of saleable items and have a great range of goods to buy.
- Don't forget that you can leave out aluminium foil, bagged batteries and small electrical items with your regular household recycling collections.
