Recycling Guide

As part of our pledge to take an active role in reducing Newent's carbon footprint and in avoiding pollution, we are producing a series of A-Z posters. Here is 'D to F'.

- **Disposable coffee cups** - take to the carton bank at Newent recycling site in the car park.
- **DIY waste** - take to one of the household waste/recycling centres.
- **Doors (wood)** - remove glass if possible and take to a household waste/recycling centre.
- **E-cigarettes** - remove batteries and place with small electrical items but remove filters and place these in general refuse with canisters. Some vape shops will accept items for recycling.
- **Egg boxes (cardboard)** - tear up and add to your compost bin, or recycle as card.
- **Electronic and Electrical items (small)** - should never be placed in your refuse bin. Bag up and place on top of the general refuse bin for separate collection. If in usable condition, take to the local Charity or Recycling shops or try the Mend & Repair cafe.
- **Engine Oil** - take to the household waste/recycling centre.
- **Fats (solid)** - do not pour liquid fats down the sink or drain. They cause blockages. Solid fats can be placed in your food caddy. Oils should be bottled and put in general waste or taken to the household waste/recycling centres.
- **Fire Extinguishers** - up to 2Kg can be accepted at household waste/recycling centres. Do not dispose of in your general waste bin.
- **Fireworks** - spent or unused - soak in a bucket for 24hrs to prevent re-ignition. Take to household waste/recycling centre and inform staff.
- **Flooring (wooden)** - take to the household waste/recycling centre.
- **Fridges** - take to the household waste/recycling centre or pay for collection on 01594 810000. If in working order, try advertising on social media or through a local newsagent.
- **Furniture** - in good condition, take to the Charity or Recycling shops. For repair to small items, try the Mend & Repair cafe.
