Public Participation SessionSpeaker 1

A member of the public asked about the replacement of a baby swing, which was removed by the Estates Team.

The clerk commented that it was removed due to advise based on a Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents (RoSPA) audit and that alternative equipment is being sourced, which will be presented to the Regeneration Committee on Monday 8th August for consideration and decision.

Speaker 2

A member of the public spoke in favour of the community build project.

Speaker 3

A member of the public requested planning application information.

The clerk commented that all information can be found on the Forest of Dean Planning Portal website.

Speaker 4

A member of the public spoke in favour of the community build and suggested the historic name of 'pavilion' to identify the building.

Speaker 5

A member of the public commented about anti-social behaviour.

The member of the public was advised to contact the police on 101 and report all anti-social behaviour directly to the police.

However, details are being clarified and it presents a way forward.

3. To decide on whether to instruct the contractor to undertake pre-construction ground works at the recreation ground.
