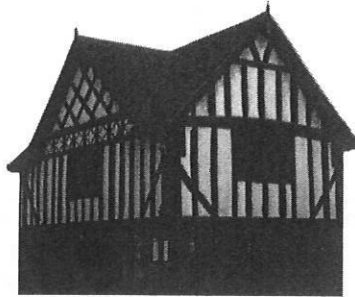

We really want to replace it and upgrade it to future proof it. It offers our cadets the opportunity to practise flying skills and carry out prerequisite training before we can send up flying in aircraft. One of our cadet leaders, Corporal Martha Green created a bid proposal which I have attached to this bid.
