Aims and Purpose of the Organisation	<p>Newent Panthers Netball Club is a new, upcoming netball club based at Newent Community School Sports Centre, Newent, Glos.</p> <p>We are an inclusive club and welcome players of all abilities to join our club and encourage them to develop their skills in a fun, safe environment.</p> <p>We strongly believe that netball helps to build confidence, enhance problem solving and decision making and develop social skills. Team sport also has a positive impact on mental health and wellbeing.</p> <p>We believe sport should be accessible to everyone, with as few barriers to entry as possible. We want everyone to play and enjoy netball as much as we do! Whilst we have to charge fees in order to cover the costs of running the club, we aim to keep our fees as low as possible.</p>

8.	For what purpose or project is the grant requested?	<p>The club is run by volunteers some of which we have managed to raise funds to enable them to complete relevant qualifications. As we have grown in size we have now needed to take on more coaches and would like to be able to put them through the same qualifications to ensure that we provide the players with the best possible opportunities. We would like to be able to offer them the following:</p> <p>2 x level 1 coaching course – total £310</p> <p>2 x level 2 coaching course – total £740</p> <p>3 x umpiring course – total £135</p> <p>We secured a grant for 30 netball dresses for the players last year, however as we now have more players we would like to be able to purchase an additional 30 dresses at a cost of £1200. As many of our players come from low income families and with the cost of living crisis we would very much like to be able to provide them with the dress so that there are no barriers for them to be able to play in the league.</p>

We currently take on players from year 3-11 and would like to encourage more boys to play the game.
