A Future for Newent

From Thursday 12th until Wednesday 18th July there will be an opportunity for everyone who lives and works in the parish of Newent (the area covered by the Town Council) to give their views on the proposed Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP).

This is a community led project of some significance which can help shape development of all types and produce a vision for the future of our town and the surrounding area.

The plan will take at least two years to complete and a Steering Group will be set up shortly consisting of people who have a stake in the community as well as town councillors.

We will hold major consultation events during the making of the NDP and there will be a final referendum for all eligible voters. Once approved, the NDP will have the same legal weight as the District Council's Local Plan. External funding is available to cover the expenses of the project.

The Town Council wants everyone who lives, works or is otherwise part of the community in Newent to have the opportunity to make their views known.

We need to protect our heritage while making the neighbourhood fit for the future. Innovative ideas and solutions welcome!
