Q - How often does the Town Council meet?

A - Meetings are usually held at 7.30pm every second and fourth Monday of the month at The Market House. Members of the public are welcome to attend.

Q - Is that all that councillors do?

A - Certainly not. They are active in working groups, sub-committees and as representatives of the council on outside bodies.

Q - Are Newent Town Councillors paid?

A - No. It is a voluntary position. Essential expenses can be claimed. At District and County level, Councillors can claim an allowance.
